





LOCAL RULES

- Anywhere through-the-green, a ball which is embedded in it's own pitch-mark in the ground may be lifted, cleaned and dropped in accordance with Rule #25-2.
- Out of bounds is defined by the split rail fence along holes 1, 2, 3, and 10. The fence behind the 18th green is an obstruction, not a boundary.

- Environmentally Sensitive Areas (ESA's) are wetlands defined by the red stakes with a green top. Players are prohibited from entering the ESA's in search of lost balls.
